Word Analogy

What is Analogy?

- **1.** Analogy is an important topic under reasoning, and many questions are asked in Sainik School exams. In this chapter, we will deal with:
 - Analogy Meaning
 - Types of Analogy

- 2. Analogy mainly refers to any kind of similarity or common properties between two or more objects. In simple terms the word analogy means to make a comparison between two objects or ideas. This is a common practice in the English language, considered helpful in writing and literature as in the daily figures of speech.
- **3.** Questions on Analogy are asked to test the ability of a candidate to understand the relationship or similarity between two or more given objects. Various types of analogy which can occur in this world or can be asked in the Sainik School examination:
 - Word Analogy
 - Alphabet Analogy
 - Number Analogy
- **4. Word Analogy:** In a word analogy, two or more words with similar properties are given, and you need to determine the analogous word for the one asked in the question. Some basic types of word analogy asked in exams are as follows:

State and Capital: In this type of analogy the first word is the name of the state and the second word is the capital of the required state or vice - versa. Some examples:

Example 1: Bihar : Patna :: Maharashtra : ?

Solution: Here we see that the capital of Bihar is Patna. Thus we write the capital of Maharashtra in the blank as:

Bihar: Patna:: Maharashtra: Mumbai

Some examples:

• **Opposite Analogy:** Smiling & crying are examples of opposite analogies, as these two words are opposite in terms of meaning.

- **Object and Classification Analogy:** Objects can be classified into groups but when the same object can be classified into different groups, it forms an object and classification analogy. **For example:** Knife & weapon, knife & kitchenware etc.
- **Object and Group Analogies:** These are objects that form a specific group when many are put together. Several wolves form a pack, several trees form a forest etc.
- **Performer and action Analogy:** In this analogy, both the performer and the right means of action are mentioned. **For example:** Painter & Paint, Writer & Write and Chef & Cook etc.
- **Antonyms:** These are the words that have an opposite meaning. **For example:** Hungry & Full, Brave & Coward, Strong & Weak etc.
- **Synonyms:** These are words that have similar or same meanings. **For example,** Hungry & Starving, Brave & Courage, Strong & Powerful.
- Analogy Questions on Gender: In this type of analogy one word is masculine and another word is feminine, or we can say a male and female relationship.

5. How to solve Analogy Questions?

You might have understood the different types of analogies that are most important in the above points. Here are some tips that will help you solve different analogy questions for competitive based exams. These are:

- The only way to make improvements in verbal analogies is by practicing.
- So, keep on practising different sets of questions every day.
- Familiarize yourself with the test format.
- If the meaning of a word is unknown, try to remember the context where you encountered the word, subject, category etc.
