Introduction.

The Rashtriya Indian Military College (RIMC) is a Dehradun-based residential School. It was founded in March 1922. Its aim is to prepare boys (and now girls also) for career in the Indian military. The RIMC is an Inter Service Category 'A' Establishment that is recognised by CBSE and is managed by the Ministry of Defence via the DGMT (Army). Aside from the CBSE curriculum, the school also prepares cadets for the UPSC examination for entry into the NDA/INA and, ultimately, the military. Till June 2022, it was an all-boys academy, but the first batch for 4 girl cadets have joined the July 2022 term.

RIMC is one of the most sought-after public schools in the country due to its high standard of education as well as its extremely high success rate in the National Defence Academy and Naval Academy selections. The education it provides is based on core values of discipline, excellence and career orientation.



Eligibility

Admissions to RIMC are made to Class 8 ONLY. Generally, one vacancy per state is allotted. However, some States which have a large population, have up to two vacancies. (Maximum vacancies per Term are 25 boys and 5 girls). There is **no other reservation** of any kind in the RIMC Selection Process.

Application Forms

The Prospectus cum Application Form and booklet of old question papers can be obtained from the RIMC, Dehradun. The candidate has to forward a selfaddressed slip and DD in favour of **'THE COMMANDANT RIMC**

DEHRADUN' for an amount of Rs. 600/-(for General), Rs 555/- (for SC/ST). RIMC will send back the material needed by Speed Post. **Online payment option is also available.**

The form is to be deposited with the respective State Governments as per the address list given in the prospectus. The application form contains detailed instructions. The admit cards are issued at least one month before the date of the exam.

Recommended Books

RIMC is a highly competitive exam. It is advisable to prepare for it well if you are appearing for it. A thorough knowledge of the basic books of Class 7 and 8 of NCERT is a MUST.

The English paper has questions on composition, unseen passages, letter writing and Grammar. In addition to the basic books on Grammar and Comprehension, it is better to go through the commercially available question banks of the last 10 years.

The GK Paper includes Science and Social Studies of Class 7 and 8 as also Current Affairs of that level. For this, the students must refer to the Question Bankof the last 10 years. In addition, they must also keep themselves updated about the current happenings of at least the last one year. This may be done through newspapers and current affairs magazines.

Interview and Results

Candidates who clear the Entrance Exam and figure in the merit list will be required to appear for interview (*Viva Voce* Test) in the month of October (for January Term) & in April (for July Term). Traits such as intelligence and personality of the candidates will be tested. Minimum pass marks for the interview are 50% (out of 50). Generally, the top 3 or 4 candidates in the written exam are called for the interview. It is conducted by a specially constituted Interview Board.



Medical



Candidates who qualify after the Interviewwill undergo a medical examination at a selected Military Hospital. Only those candidates who are found medically fit will be considered. The details of the medical exams are available on the RIMC website. The Final Merit List will be uploaded on the RIMC website (www.rimc.gov.in).

Board Exams

RIMC figures in the Limca Book of Records for being the first and only Military School in India where exams for Class 10th& 12th are conducted twice a year, in the month of May and November. These exams are recognized by CBSE. The school offers Science Stream at the 10+2 level. However, to prepare cadets for UPSC examination for entry to NDA, Social Sciences are also taught.

Withdrawals

The candidates can be withdrawn at any time on the request by parent or by a decision of the College at the rate of Rs. 2876/- per week (plus thescholarship amount). *Parents/guardians are advised to refer to the RIMCWebsite for the latest update on this.*

Girls in RIMC

The good news is, That girls have been permitted to appear for the RIMC exam from 2021 onwards. The first batch reported for training in **August 2022**. Girls must prepare right now to avail this opportunity. The eligibility and selection criteria are same as that for the boys. There are 5 seats for girls per term. The states have been clubbed in 5 geographical zones and 1 vacancy has been allotted per zone.
